20. INTERESTS:

I. Skull Base:

With the advent of cranial facial osteotomies, established in the late 1950's by Paul Tessier, MD, it became possible to develop transfacial approaches for complex midline skull base lesions. Throughout the years, these craniofacial principles were built upon to develop techniques that have made lesions, that were once considered insurmountable, approachable with the confidence of curative resection. In 1990, we established a skull base team at Barrow Neurological Institute, as we recognized the value that it offered the skull base patient. It became apparent to me that many of our craniofacial principles combined with new osteotomies and degloving techniques utilizing could be combined and organized into a logical classification scheme to approach to the skull base. In 1992 I described these new techniques (Levels II, III and IV – see enclosed articles) and their application which was based on selecting the most appropriate angle of approach to the anatomic site of the tumor. I felt that a direct anterior approach was optimal as it offers advantages such as: 1) an anterior access through a relatively avascular midline plane; 2) a reduced surgical distance to the lesion; 3) avoidance of critical neurovascular structures, the temporomandibular joint and muscles of mastication; and 4) seldom requires facial incisions. Between 1990 and 1998, 63 patients (39 males and 24 females) underwent a transfacial approach for resection of midline skull base lesions utilizing the six level classification scheme that I have described. As a result I have had the opportunity to collect data and examine long term outcomes, in several journal articles,

seven book chapters and almost 20 presentations at national and international meetings.

II. Dynamic Orthotic Cranioplasty (DOC Band)/ Cranial Remodeling:

In the late 1980's, I joined forces with Kim Manwaring, MD, and an orthotist, Jeanne Pomatto, to address the need for a non-surgical approach to the non-synostotic, misshapen head of the neonate. As a result, Dynamic Orthotic Cranioplasty (D.O.C.) was developed. By 1988, Cranial Technologies, owned and operated by Jeanne Pomatto, began using the DOC Band™ on infants that did not have craniosynostosis but a more benign problem due to their sleep position, known as “positional plagiocephaly” or “deformational plagiocephaly”. In 1992, the National Institute of Health, launched a public awareness program entitled, the “Back to Sleep” campaign. Their goal was to reduce the incidence of deaths related to SIDS. By 1994, the American Academy of Pediatrics endorsed this movement and formally recommended that all newborns be slept on their backs. Subsequently, many specialists saw a dramatic increase in the number of referrals with deformational plagiocephaly. It was apparent that this was not a sudden increase in the incidence of craniosynostosis but it was deformational plagiocephaly, now in greater numbers due to the increased trend of infants sleeping on their backs. As a result, the DOC Band was used much more frequently and offered us an opportunity to do some excellent research on this interesting condition.

SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS

Dr. Stephen Beals' bibliography lists many peer-reviewed papers and articles, several (26) which include mentees/residents as co-authors. In addition, he has written several book chapters. Three examples of his significant written contributions include:

1. **The use of miniplates in craniomaxillofacial surgery (Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery**

79:1, 1987) This publication was the first major study on the use of rigid fixation for craniofacial surgery in the American literature. It helped pioneer the use of miniplates in craniofacial surgery in the United States, and became a mainstay in craniofacial surgery today. As a result, we have enjoyed improved primary bone healing and stability of segments and can offer patients better results with less anticipation for secondary surgery.

2. **Treatment of positional plagiocephaly with dynamic orthotic cranioplasty (D.O.C.) (Journal of Craniofacial Surgery 5:150-159, July, 1994)** Prior to the publication of this paper, there was no objective data available that proved the effectiveness of cranial orthotics in the treatment of positional plagiocephaly. This research led to further confirmation that the use of dynamic cranioplasty was not only effective but also a safe alternative in treating these cases where surgery was eventually deemed unwarranted. It became the core data which was later expanded into a larger sample of our patients, which led the FDA to clear the D.O.C. Band as the first cranial orthosis approved for the treatment of deformational plagiocephaly in the United States. (see page 24 of CV for bibliography of DOC)
3. **Posterior skull base transfacial approaches. (Clinics of Plastic Surgery 22(3): 491-511, 1995.** This article detailed new exposures to the midline skull base and offered a hierarchy of classification to help the surgeon and his team, logically choose the best approach. It revolutionized surgical access to the midline skull base, offering more single staged resection, shorter operating times and successful reconstruction of the facial units with restored function and aesthetics. These techniques made an area that once seemed insurmountable, approachable through deductive reasoning, lending to greater curative confidence for the surgeon and their patient.
